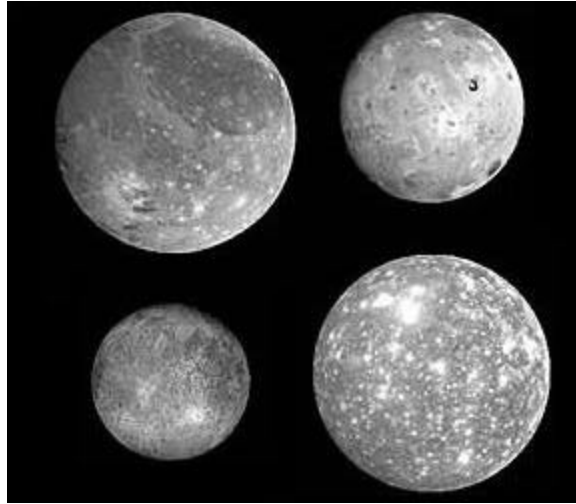


## Satellites of Jupiter

All the images were taken by the Galileo spacecraft in 1996 and 1997 during its orbital tour of the Jovian system, except for the globe of Callisto, which was taken in 1979 by the Voyager spacecraft.
